

Personal Equipment List

Required

- **Official Scout uniform(s)**
for your current Scouting position
(*Note:* A complete uniform includes the official shirt; shorts, long pants, skirts, or culottes; socks; and belt. A neckerchief and slide will be provided.)
- **Scout activity uniform(s)**
(*Note:* An activity uniform includes a Scout T-shirt or knit shirt and Scout shorts, long pants, skirts, or culottes.)
- Shoes or boots (not white, please, and broken-in for Hiking 2nd Weekend)
- Scout cap (baseball, type, representing the Scouting program with which you are associated)
- **Personal First Aid Kit**
- **Windbreaker or jacket**
- **Rain gear** (poncho or rain suit)
- **Underwear**
- **Sock liners – silk or polypropylene, NOT cotton** (2nd weekend)
- **Handkerchiefs**
- **Sunscreen**
- **Insect repellent** (no aerosols, please)
- **Tent with mosquito netting** (2nd weekend only)
- **Ground pad**, air mattress, or cot
- **Sleeping bag**
- **Folding camp chair**
- **Flashlight** with spare batteries and bulb
- **Pocketknife** or multiple tool-type knife (no fixed-blade knives)
- **Medication in labeled containers**
- **Toiletries**
- **Towels and washcloths**
- **1 ½ inch three ring notebook/View Binder**
- **Pens, pencils, pocket notebook**
- **Canteen** or water bottle
- **Mess Kit and utensils** (2nd weekend)
- **Handbook** for your Scouting program
- **Backpack** for carrying your gear to and from the site of the outdoor experience (2nd weekend)

Optional

- **Pillow**
- **Change of shoes**
- **Moccasins or camp slippers**
- **Shower footwear**
- **Sunglasses**
- **Religious book(s)**
- **Books of camp songs, skits, etc.**
- **Camera and film**

Note: The following electronic devices may not be used during a Wood Badge course: cellular telephones, pagers, radios, televisions, CD players, tape players, and any other devices that could interrupt Wood Badge presentations or activities.
